Set within glorious Lake District countryside, Lowther Castle has everything – history, horticulture and landscape.

Lowther has been home to the family of that name since the 12th century. Lowther Castle, the third building on the site, was created in 1806 and demolished 150 years later. Its vast gardens have been in place since the 17th century.

Today, to visit Lowther is to enjoy a magnificent ruin, expansive and atmospheric gardens and a wonderful Lakeland setting. Culturally curious visitors can explore *The Story of Lowther* exhibition and learn the history of the family and the place; the horticulturally curious can take their journey outside and discover such gems as the Japanese Garden, Dan Pearson's Garden-in-the-Ruins, the ancient Yew Avenue.

With a huge wooden adventure playground, a café serving delicious freshly made food and a shop selling a wide range of bespoke and carefully chosen goods, Lowther Castle has something for everyone.

HOW TO FIND US

Lowther Castle, Penrith CA10 2HH

From the North: M6 exit at J40. Follow A66 east to next roundabout, then take the A6 south for 3 miles. Follow the signs for Lowther Castle.

From the South: M6 exit at J39. Follow A6 north for 8 miles. Follow the signs for Lowther Castle.

From the East or West: From A66, at Penrith, follow A6 south for 3 miles. Follow the signs for Lowther Castle.
