Nothing will prepare you for the scale and beauty of Lowther Castle, set in a quintessential English parkland landscape. A remarkable ruined Gothic castle set in ancient Gardens – now an award-winning attraction. Your clients will leave feeling both enlightened and inspired not just by the setting of Lowther – which occupies a stunning and unspoilt corner of the Lake District National Park - but also by the story of the castle and gardens' transformation.

The restoration of Lowther Castle & Gardens is a remarkable story. In 1999, Lowther's gardens were overrun with weeds; the castle, deroofed in 1957, was derelict. Today, the castle ruins are planted as a garden while the remainder of the gardens, though still in the early stages of restoration, are winning wide acclaim in horticultural circles.

And Lowther is full of stories. Visitors interested in gardens and history will find lots to enjoy – so too will visitors interested in colourful characters. The family has lived in this spot since the 12th century and over those years, has had its fair share of eccentric and exciting moments. History, horticulture, architecture and fun. All in all, a unique attraction with a great deal to offer.

Take a look at the experiences currently available. Choose a simple visit; combine the visit with an insightful Garden tour and delightful dining; or make a day of it and book a visit to Lowther Castle & Gardens followed by a relaxing cruise on one of the Lake District's most beautiful and peaceful lakes, Ullswater.

Lowther Castle is very conveniently located - a stone's throw from Ullswater (only 5 miles away) and only 15 minutes from the M6 (J40). 30 minutes from Carlisle, with the Scottish border only 45 minutes away: a perfect place to break the journey while travelling north or south.

Castle & Gardens Visit

Arrive to a warm Lowther welcome on your coach.

Take a short walk towards Lowther Castle. As you make your way downhill, the Castle is revealed in all its splendour*.

Your group will be led into the Courtyard for a 10-minute scene-setter. The guide will give a brief introductory talk on this magnificent castle's colourful life and the estate, which has been the home of the Lowther family for 850 years.

** this is a short stroll of about 5 minutes but if necessary, an alternative shorter route, through the Archway to the Courtyard is an option. The Archway also provides cover if the weather is not so good.*

Once the group has had a little insight into Lowther Castle, they can enter The Story of Lowther Exhibition, which leads to the Castle and ancient Gardens.

Everyone will receive a map of the gardens.

Admission rate to the Exhibition & Gardens is £7 per person.

This is a discounted travel trade rate, offered to companies making an advance booking for FIT and group clients. The meet and greet and introduction to Lowther Castle & Gardens is offered as an added value, optional extra at no additional charge to groups of 10 pax upwards.

DURATION: from 1hr minimum to all day, if desired

Castle & Gardens Visit, Stay for Refreshment, Lunch or Afternoon Tea


Your Meet & Greet on the coach; Courtyard introduction and entry to exhibition and gardens, followed or preceded by the catering option of your choice.

For pre-booked groups also visiting the Castle & Gardens, catering can be served in the Sculpture Gallery, which will be ready from 1 April 2019, having been beautifully refurbished by Jim Lowther's wife Vanessa. (Artist's impression right) The Sculpture Gallery has a picturesque view over the Castle ruins & Gardens.

At quieter times, the Café is available for pre-booked groups. The Café is before the pay point and overlooks the very attractive Courtyard, once the stableyard and home to a string of 50 horses.

Castle & Garden Visit, with Head Gardener Tour

In addition to the Meet & Greet and Courtyard introduction to Lowther Castle, those with a particular interest in the Gardens are offered the special experience of a Garden Tour with Head Gardener, Martin Ogle.

Martin has looked after the famous 130 acres of garden for the last seven years since the very start of the restoration work. Tour highlights to include:

- the history of the rescue of Lowther Gardens from wilderness
- early intervention of international landscape designer, Dan Pearson
- design of the new Gardens including the Parterre and Garden-in-the-Ruins
- some well-chosen horticultural secrets
- free time to explore Lowther Castle ruins & The Story of Lowther Exhibition

This is a walking tour of the gardens. As an option, a talk about the gardens with visual presentation using an extensive archive of images covering the full restoration project, can be presented within the seated venue of the Sculpture Gallery.

Lowther Castle & Gardens and Ullswater Steamers: Day Out

Combine a visit to Lowther Castle & Gardens with a lake cruise on the stunning lake Ullswater. Ullswater is an 8-mile journey from Lowther, the journey taking visitors through the chocolate box village of Askham, to Pooley Bridge or Glenridding. An 8-mile journey. Visitors can take the cruise before or after their visit to Lowther, combining a tour of the Castle & Gardens with lunch in the Sculpture Gallery or Café.

COST £14 plus your chosen lunch option at Lowther Castle & Gardens. Available to groups of 10 pax upwards.



* The route to Ullswater Steamers takes you through Lowther parkland. Notes for the tour guide are available to add interest to this journey. This includes the option of a brief stop at Lowther Castle church, which is always open. It is here you will find the final resting places of Wicked Jimmy; William the Good and the Yellow Earl.

These are special tours and activities to make a visit more unique for your clients. They include:


